



The Adams County Fair – we are the makers of life-long happy memories that have been enjoyed by multi-generations of families!

The 2012 Fair will take place August 1-5 at the Adams County Regional Park Complex in Brighton, Colorado. The estimated attendance at the 2011 event was 68,000 and was on par with 2010. The largest attended days continue to be Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

One of the top reasons that people come to the Adams County Fair is for the FOOD!! They are looking for NEW and EXCITING food trends – so I hope everyone has some NEW and EXCITING menu items!

The Adams County Fair has limited food vending spaces available for the 2012 show and you are invited to submit your menu for consideration to participate at the 2012 event. Please keep in mind that we are looking for NEW and EXCITING food trends!

Some examples from around the country include:

- Chocolate covered jalapeno peppers
- Deep fried cookie dough
- Deep fried peanut butter and jelly sandwich
- Deep fried pineapple upside down cake
- Walking tacos

All food vendors will be required to provide:

1. Menu with pricing – regular priced, full size items
2. Children’s menu with pricing – for the duration of the fair
 - a. A children’s meal that includes entrée, side and drink
3. Meal deal menu with pricing – for the duration of the fair
 - a. Means a meal that includes entrée, side and drink

We are in the process of securing a new beverage sponsor. All bottled water, soda, and BIB must be purchased through the Adams County Fair. Once the beverage sponsor is announced, you will be required to refrain from bringing in the competitors products from outside retailers as it is not acceptable and against the rules and regulations of the Adams County Fair.

Food Vending Space Locations:

M1 through M6 - 20 x 20 vending space

Flat fee of \$2,000.00

Located on the main independent midway on the north side of the barns

Spaces include:

1. Electricity (20, 30, or 50 amp service available)
2. Potable water (vendor must provide food grade hose and back flow preventer)
3. Gray water tanks
4. Grease containers

M7 through M10 – 15 x 15 vending space

Flat fee of \$1,300.00

Spaces include:

1. Electricity (20, 30, or 50 amp service available)
2. Potable water (vendor must provide food grade hose & back flow preventer)

M11 through M14 – 10 x 10 vending space

Flat fee of \$700.00

Spaces include:

1. Electricity (20 or 30 amp service available)

Grandstands 1 through 4 – sizes vary

Flat fee of \$760.00

Spaces include:

1. Potable water (vendor must provide food grade hose and back flow preventor)
2. Electricity (20 or 30 amp service available)

Exhibit Hall

Flat fee of \$700.00

Includes small work area with a sink & refrigerator; tables and chairs provided upon availability
