



2010 Adams County Fair Parade Rules & Regulations

Date: Saturday, July 31st
Assembly Time: 8:30 a.m. – Units will be in position by 9:30 a.m.
Staging Area: On the corner of 19th & Bridge Street in the parking lot of the old location for Front Range Community College

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Each applicant must fill out an application form.
2. There is no entry fee.
3. The parade is limited to the first 90 entries.
4. No entry or entrant in the parade shall perform movements or drills that will impede the forward movement of the parade.
5. No amplified advertising will be allowed.
6. No advertising within the parade except by hand delivery.
7. It would be appreciated if all vehicle entries bear a card identifying the year and make. All automobile entries within the same group/organization will be staged side by side two at a time.
8. Parade entries must be no higher than 12'6" and no wider than 12'.
9. Cancellations should be reported by July 27th.
10. Your designated representative can enter the staging area at 19th & Bridge Street – parking lot of the old location of Front Range Community College.
11. All entries will receive line-up number assignments at the Staging Area. Assign one individual in your unit to pick up your number on parade day. Display the number on the left side of your entry for identification by the announcer.

MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION

Parade Route

1. The parade route is approximately 1.6 miles in length and will travel from 19th & Bridge Street West to 4th Avenue; turn left (south) on 4th Avenue to the de-staging area at 450 South 4th Avenue. The reviewing stand is at the corner of 4th & Bridge. Please limit performances in the area to no longer than 1 minute.

Staging Area

1. Staging area maps will be sent to all participants prior to the parade.

Horse Trailer Parking

1. There is one location for horse trailer parking. Please proceed to the dirt field on 19th & Bridge behind Walgreens.

General Participant Parking

1. Parade participants may park at the Lucky Lanes Bowling Alley located at 1850 Bridge Street and also at 1931 Bridge Street on the east side of the check in area.

Finishing the Parade Route

1. After completing the parade route, the preferred route back to parked vehicles/trailers is to proceed to Southern East to 19th or Jessup East to 19th.

General Notes

1. Due to the length of the parade, it is required that car clubs travel the parade route side by side by two columns.
2. **No candy is to be thrown to the crowd from moving vehicles or floats.** If you wish to distribute candy, you must have people walking near the curbs to hand to the crowd. There will be no exceptions! If an infraction to this rule occurs, your unit(s) may not be allowed to participate in future parades.
